Introduction

D' Learning Group values the trust our users and customers place in us when they give us access to their personal data. The Privacy Policy describes how we work to maintain that trust and protect that information. This Privacy Policy details our collection, use and disclosure of personal data you give to us when you access or use our website.

This privacy policy has been compiled to better serve those who are concerned with how their 'Personally Identifiable Information' (PII) is being used online. PII, as described in US privacy law and information security, is information that can be used on its own or with other information to identify, contact, or locate a single person, or to identify an individual in context. Please read our privacy policy carefully to get a clear understanding of how we collect, use, protect or otherwise handle your Personally Identifiable Information in accordance with our website.

This Privacy Policy covers only data that we collect through the website, and not any other data collection or processing, including, without limitation, the data collection practices of any affiliate or other third party, including any third-party operators of web pages to which the website links, and any information that we collect offline or through any websites, products, or services that do not display a direct link to this Privacy Policy.

Personal information we collect from the people that visit our website

When do we collect information?

We collect information from you when you register on our site or enter information on our site. D' Learning Group shall retain users' Personal Data to the extent such retention is adequate, relevant and limited to what is necessary for the purposes for which they are processed. D' Learning Group shall not retain Personal Data for any longer than necessary for the purposes of performing the processing outlined in this Privacy Policy.

How do we use your information?

We may use the information we collect from you when you register, respond to a survey, surf the website, or use certain other site features in the following ways:

- when cooperation is required with lawful interceptions, search warrants or other judicial proceedings that D' Learning Group determines, at its sole discretion, to be valid or applicable.

D' Learning Group declines any intention to censor, edit or become involved in a permanent revision or vigilance of the communications stored in or transmitted through its facilities by clients or others. Nevertheless, D' Learning Group will revise, suppress or block access to communications that may be prejudicial to D' Learning Group, its clients or third parties. The circumstances under which D' Learning Group will bring an action to court include, but are not limited to, real or potential breach of D' Learning Group Acceptable Use Policy.

How do we protect your information?

We do not use vulnerability scanning and/or scanning to PCI standards. We only provide articles, information and registration services. We never ask for credit card numbers. We do not use Malware Scanning.

Your personal information is contained behind secured networks and is only accessible by a limited number of persons who have special access rights to such systems and are required to keep the information confidential. In addition, all sensitive information you supply is encrypted via Secure Socket Layer (SSL) technology. We implement a variety of security measures when a user enters, submits, or accesses their information to maintain the safety of your personal information.

D' Learning Group seeks to use reasonable security measures to help protect against the loss, misuse and alteration of the Personal Data under our control. No method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage, is 100% secure, however. In addition, please note that emails, messages sent via your web browser, and other similar means of communication with other users, are not encrypted. Therefore, while we strive to protect your information, we cannot guarantee its security.

Please also be aware that we may use third-party cloud service providers that provide hosting, data storage and other services pursuant to standard terms and conditions that may be nonnegotiable; these service providers have informed us or the general public that they apply security measures they consider adequate for the protection of information within their system, or they have a general reputation for applying such measures. However, we will not be liable (to the fullest extent permitted by law) for any damages that may result from the misuse of any information, including Personal Data, by these companies.

Use of cookies

We do not use cookies for tracking purposes. We compile aggregate data about site traffic and site interactions in order to offer better site experiences and tools in the future. We may also use trusted third-party services that track this information on our behalf.

You can choose to have your computer warn you each time a cookie is being sent, or you can choose to turn off all cookies. You do this through your browser settings. Since every browser is a little different, look at your browser's Help Menu to learn the correct way to modify your cookies.

We have implemented Demographics and Interests Reporting

We, along with third-party vendors such as Google use first-party cookies such as the Google Analytics cookies. We make use of Google Analytics to collect anonymous information about users browsing the website for the purpose of gathering statistical information regarding the number of visits it receives.

Third-party disclosure

We do not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer to outside parties your Personally Identifiable Information unless we provide users with advance notice. This does not include website hosting partners and other parties who assist us in operating our website, conducting our business, or serving our users, so long as those parties agree to keep this information confidential. We may also release information when its release is appropriate to comply with the law, enforce our site policies, or protect ours or others' rights, property or safety.

However, non-personally identifiable visitor information may be provided to other parties for marketing, advertising, or other uses.

Occasionally, at our discretion, we may include or offer third-party products or services on our website. These third-party sites have separate and independent privacy policies. We therefore have no responsibility or liability for the content and activities of these linked sites. Fair Information Practices

The Fair Information Practices Principles and the concepts they include have played a significant role in the development of data protection laws around the globe. We will notify you via email within 1 business day.

This principle requires not only that individuals have enforceable rights against data users, but also that individuals have recourse to courts or government agencies to investigate and/or prosecute non-compliance by data processors.

CAN SPAM Act

The CAN-SPAM Act is a law that sets the rules for commercial email, establishes requirements for commercial messages, gives recipients the right to have emails stopped from being sent to them, and spells out tough penalties for violations.
